

# Handling Collection for World War I

## List of items for loan

- Jacket *with belt clips*
- Webbing *belt that holds bandages, ammunition, etc. worn over the jacket*
- Dummy Round Bullet and Stripper Clip
- Brass Oiling Tool
- Newspapers *authentic, soldier's writing, instruction booklets*
- Bandolier *worn over shoulder, usually by cavalry holds 90 rounds for a rifle*
- Gun Cleaning Equipment
- WWI Medals *authentic, but not named*
- WWI Sergeant Stripes and King George Badge
- Medic's Water Bottle *larger opening for the wounded with enough water for 1.5 soldiers*
- Soldier's Water Bottle *24hr ration with felt cover to keep insulated*
- Two-Up Game *with instructions - excellent for teaching probability*
- Papers and Maps *rationing order, postcards, letter*
- Compass *authentic artefact with notes*
- Spurs *cavalry spurs, plus dress spurs for parades*
- Buttons *large collection from uniforms*
- Rank Insignia *worn on the shoulders*
- The ANZAC Book *original artefact from 1916*
- Teacher Resource

NOTE: Not all items may be available all of the time, so sending us a priority list is recommended. There may also be extra items included, depending on their availability.

It is also worth noting that while this is a 'handling' collection, our resources are finite and we need them to last as long as possible. Please handle them carefully to allow them to be available for others.

Items must be checked back into the box and returned with the appropriate paperwork.
